



Chris Ruff is a professor at the Johns Hopkins University School of Medicine. He serves as director of the Center for Functional Anatomy and Evolution and also holds an appointment in the Department of Orthopaedic Surgery. He studies how variation in skeletal morphology is related to mechanical forces applied during life.
